## UNIT OF EXCELLENCE



The Mishigami Lodge Unit of Excellence Program (OAUX) was designed to encourage units to utilize the Order of the Arrow in creating an outstanding unit program. OAUX measures the unit in five (5) key areas.

1) Leadership: Utilize the OA Unit Representative Program (see <a href="https://bit.ly/OAunitREP">https://bit.ly/OAunitREP</a>). Ensure that the Senior Youth Leader appoints one Scout as OA Unit Representative, and the Unit Leader appoints one adult as adviser to that young person.

2) Participation: Promote chapter, area and lodge events and help with transportation for those who need it. At least 50% of unit OA members attend at least one chapter, area, or lodge event during the year in addition to their own Induction Weekend.

3) Elections: Schedule a unit election with the chapter election team annually. Hold an election and have 70% of elected Ordeal Candidates inducted. If no Scouts are eligible for election, an OA Unit Visit must be scheduled in lieu of an OA Unit Election.

4) Planning: Review the Mishigami Lodge calendar with the youth leadership during annual unit program planning and schedule unit events so that unit programs do not conflict with any chapter, area, or lodge events. Exception granted for chapter meetings if unit meets on the same day of the week as the chapter. Must clear conflicts of at least two (2), but not all Induction Weekends.

5) Activation: Demonstrate the depth of your unit's OA program through active participation in OA events. At least 50% of recently inducted members attend at least one chapter, area, or lodge event within the first 12 months after induction.
